The affiliation of the R C C Institute of Technology, College of Leather Technology Campus, Canal South Road, Calcutta - 700 015 to the University be granted in respect of the courses : (i) Computer Engineering and (ii) Information Technology for one year with effect from 1999-2000 academic session. This affiliation is accorded under the provision of the K.U. Act 1981, Section 4(4) and Section 5(3), read with the Govt. of West Bengal, Higher Education Department Notification No.41(7)-Edn(U) 4E-29/98

dated 14.01.1999. As per sub-section (3) of Section 5 of the K.U. Act 1981, the following conditions and restrictions are imposed in according affiliation of the R C C Institute of Technology to the University of Kalyani, subject to the approval of the State Government

1. The land and other properties shall be duly registered in the name of the R C C Institute of Technology .
2. The Governing Body of the R C C Institute of Technology shall be constituted following the AICTE guidelines as follows:
 - i) President to be from among the Governing Body members- nominated by the sponsors.
 - ii) Nominee of the AICTE - Regional Officer (Ex-Officio)
 - iii) An Industrialist/Technologist/Educationalist from the Region to be nominated by the concerned Regional Committee as nominee of the AICTE out of the panel approved by the Chairman of the AICTE.
 - iv) Two nominees of the University of Kalyani.
 - v) Nominee of the State Govt. - Director of Technical Education (Ex-Officio)
 - vi) An Industrialist/Technologist/Educationalist from the region nominated by the State Government. *Tapan K. Mitra/gmit*
 - vii) One representative from amongst the Teachers of the Institute
 - viii) One representative from amongst the members of the non-teaching staff of the Institute.
 - ix) Not more than 6(six) members to be nominated by the sponsors.
 - x) Principal/Director of the Institute - Member Secretary - nominated by the sponsors.
3. i) The management of the Institute shall provide funds for investment in Developing land and in providing the related infrastructure and other facilities as per the AICTE norms and standard laid down by AICTE from time to time and for meeting the recurring expenditure.

- ii) The courses or programmes shall be conducted as per the assessed technical manpower demands.
- iii) The admission shall be made according to regulations and direction of AICTE for such admission in the respective technical College.
- iv) Admission of the students will be made on the basis of the list published by the Board of West Bengal Joint Entrance Examinations in Engineering. Reservation of SC and ST candidates shall be as per State Govt. rules.
- v) The Institution shall not cause or allow either the closure of the Institution or discontinuation of any course of study or start any new courses or alter the intake capacity of seats without the prior concurrence of the University of Kalyani, the State Govt. and AICTE.
- vi) No capitation fee shall be charged from the students/guardians in any form.
- vii) Fees for students shall not be enhanced without prior approval of the University and the State Government and shall be to the satisfaction of the University and the State Government.
- viii) The budget estimate for the Institute for the Year 1999 - 2000 be sent to the University as early as possible and preferably by 08.10.99.
- ix) The accounts of the Institute shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant. Annual report of activities of the college along with the audit/statement of accounts of a year should be sent to the University regularly by August of the following year.
- 4.1 The teachers of the Institute shall be appointed by the Governing Body of the Institute, and all such appointments are to be ratified by the University. The Selection Committee for the selection of Teachers will be as follows :-
 - a) The President of the Governing Body - Chairman of the Selection Committee.
 - b) Dean, Faculty of Engineering, Technology and Management, University of Kalyani, or a Faculty member of Kalyani University, nominated by the Vice-Chancellor.
 - c) 3 (Three) experts in the subject as follows :-
 - (i) One to be nominated by the Governing Body.
 - (ii) One to be nominated by the State Government.
 - (iii) One to be nominated by the University.
 - (iv) The member-Secretary of the Governing Body will be the member-Secretary of the Selection Committee.
- 5. The introduction of one or more additional subject(s) in future shall require the periodic approval of the University and State Government after due processing by the Governing Body.

1. Any such proposal shall be forwarded to the University by the Governing Body at least 5 (five) months before the start of an academic session.
6. Service conditions, and service benefits of the members of the staff (including Non-teaching and Teaching) shall be in accordance with the provisions of K.U. Act/Statute/Ordinance.
7. The land in the name of the R C C Institute of Technology and building thereon shall be solely used and utilised for running the Engineering courses as approved by the University and not for any other purposes.
8. The Regulations, Curricula and Syllabi of the courses shall be as per statutes and rules of the University.
9. Funds of the Institute shall be used exclusively for the Institute and shall be managed by the Governing Body and shall have no connection with any other College/Institutions/Organisations.
10. The location and names of the Institution shall not be changed without prior approval of the University and the State Government.
11. The approved courses and the intake capacity will be :-

i) Computer Engineering and	60
ii) Information Technology	60

The approved courses shall commence as per schedule of the academic calendar of the University or in the month of July-August of each academic year.
12. The conditions mentioned in the AICTE's of approval should be strictly followed.
